October 3, 2024 @ 2:00 p.m. in Woodland Park

(\*Cruising refers to measuring volume in trees)

Join forester Kerry Gyekis for a walk in the woods on the trails of the "Wellsboro Wilds" to scope out the history and condition of forester tracts and to identify and measure trees, as you look at how to understand the backstory of a forest and how to improve your private or community forest for the future. The group will measure and identify tree species and discuss strategies for coming up with desired outcomes in the forest. A maximum of five participants will meet at Woodland Park and walk and discuss for about 45 minutes on a natural trail (flat & cleared, but not improved with gravel/sand). Waterproof and sturdy walking shoes a must. Depending on demand, future walks may be scheduled in the coming weeks.
